Arranging treatment instead of incarceration (where possible)

collaboration with courts/judges

Social Work Services

- help with accessing VA benefits
- housing referrals/assistance
- employment services
- residential treatment referrals

Health Care Services

- medical, dental, pharmacy, prosthetic
- inpatient hospital services

Mental Health Services

- sexual trauma counseling
- Vet Center counseling referrals
- substance abuse treatment
- PTSD & TBI treatment
